Take Notice that the undersigned will accept nominations for the office of councillor in District 8 in the Municipality of the County of Victoria for which a by-election will be held on the **20th day of November, 2010**. District 8 is comprised of the area north of Effie's Brook and includes the communities of South Harbour, Dingwall, Cape North, Sunrise, Big Intervale, Aspy Bay, Sugar Loaf, Bay Road Valley, St. Margaret's Village, Bay St. Lawrence, Capstick and Black Point to the Victoria/Inverness border.

And Take Notice that a nomination shall be filed at the office of the Returning Officer at the County Court House in Baddeck on Nomination Day which is **Tuesday, 26th October, 2010** between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., or by **appointment only** during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. to 12 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.) in the two week period preceding Nomination Day (Tuesday, 12th, October, to Monday, 25th October, 2010).

A \$200.00 deposit is required in the form of cash, money order, or certified cheque. This deposit must accompany the nomination papers. Also please take notice that all outstanding property taxes owed to the Municipality of Victoria County must be paid in full on or before Nomination Day. To be eligible to run for council a person must be (a) a Canadian citizen; (b) the age of eighteen years old; and (c) a resident of the Municipality for six months prior to election day.

Invitation to Tender SNOW REMOVAL

Sealed tenders, clearly marked for the above, will be received by the undersigned up until 12:00 noon on Friday, November 5, 2010, for:

- A price per trip for plowing the snow from the Court House driveway and parking lot.
- A price per hour for removing the snow, as required, from the Court House driveway and parking lot.
- A price per hour for sanding the above and the Baddeck Municipal Solid Waste Transfer Station road as required.

Award will be based on the price per trip for plowing the snow and the successful contractor will provide service for all of the above.

Work to begin immediately upon award and shall continue until May 27, 2011, on an as required basis.

Contractor shall provide proof of liability insurance in force prior to commencing work.

Price shall include H.S.T.

Contractor shall be responsible for damage to property caused by his machinery and shall be responsible to provide all safety equipment, warning signs, etc. during the snow removal operation.
