The voting hours for advance polls will be from **12 noon to 8:00 pm**.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

Every person who (a) is the full age of **eighteen years** on the day of the by-election; (b) is a **Canadian citizen** on by-election day; and (c) has been ordinarily residing in the Municipality of Victoria County for a **period of three months** prior to the by-election day, and continues to so reside.

Residents of the Municipality of Victoria County, otherwise qualified to vote, but not on the final list of voters, may vote on **Saturday, November 20th** by presenting evidence of identification and residency to the Deputy Returning Officer at the poll and by swearing to and signing an oath of affirmation.
