

**Step 1 BEFORE YOU CALL**

- Decide when you want to hunt
  - Season 1: September 27 to October 2
  - Season 2: October 4 to October 9
  - Season 3: December 14 to December 16
- Decide where you want to hunt (see map). For legal description of zones visit the website.
- 2009 Moose Harvest Success Rates are available on the website.
- Have your Wildlife Resources Card in hand.


**Step 2 CALL 1-900-565-3337 TO APPLY**  
 This is not an information line. You will be charged \$6.29 (plus tax) every time this number is called. The charge will be billed to the phone used to make the call. Charges cannot be billed to another number. You cannot apply using a cell phone. You may apply only once. If you have questions about the draw, contact your local DNR office before you call the application line.


**Step 3 PUBLIC DRAW**
