Notice of Public Hearing

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT The Council of the Municipality of the County of Victoria intends to consider and, if deemed advisable, accept the following:

- 1) An application by Mr. Elliot Fraser to rezone a portion of a property on Shore Road (PID# 85018364) from commercial to residential in order to permit the use of a cabin as a single-detached dwelling. The staff recommendation is to amend Chapter 2, Section B.4 of the Baddeck Municipal Planning Strategy to add a policy permitting parcels within the Commercial designation to be re-zoned from Tourist Commercial (C-3) to Residential Urban (R-1), only when the parcel to be re-zoned is immediately adjacent to a parcel already zoned Residential Urban (R-1), and subject to the criteria for amending the Land Use By-law found in Chapter 4, Section C.2 of the Municipal Planning Strategy. Further, staff are recommending that the area of the property subject to the application be rezoned from Tourist Commercial (C-3) to Residential Urban (R-1), as requested.

There will be a Public Hearing in the Court House, Baddeck on **Monday, January 9, 2012 at 4:30 p.m.** Any written or oral presentation or objections to the proposed rezoning may be made before Council at this time.

Copies of the staff report, which includes a map showing the area affected by the proposed amendment, may be inspected by interested persons at the Victoria County offices in the Courthouse in Baddeck or at the Eastern District Planning Commission office at 32 Paint Street, Unit 4, Port Hawkesbury, Nova Scotia between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays. The plan documents and staff report are also available on the Planning Commission website at www.edpc.ca
