Coach Sandy Watling told the team before the game "Go out there get it" and that's what Baddeck did. Donald Halfpenny sunk the puck into the back of the net in the first period. Joseph MacDonell scored Baddeck's second goal and Donald Halfpenny scored the third goal before Inverness entered the score board. Shane Whitty scored one more goal in the third period to win the game 4-1. The Bobcats were very excited to take home the goal medals and the tournament banner.
