Community groups and organizations are reminded that the deadline for applications for grants through the six volunteer Community Health Boards (CHBs) within the Cape Breton District Health Authority is Saturday, November 5th.

The grants help to support organizations or community based initiatives that promote healthy eating, active living, mental health, coping skills, healthy child development and improved personal health.

The grant funding is provided to the CHBs from two sources. The District contributes funds that are directed to the "Communities In Motion" and "Healthy Eating" initiatives. Nova Scotia Health and Wellness funds the "Wellness Initiative" grants. Each CHB reviews applications from the area it represents and

awards the grants. No project is considered too small. They can include new programs, pilot projects, one-time events or on-going community initiatives.

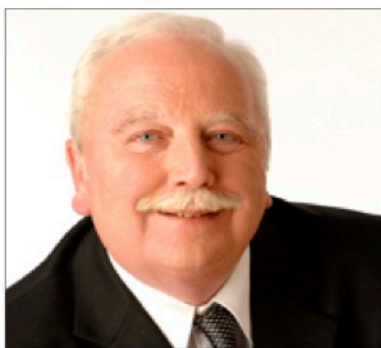
